

Who are We?

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta, Inc. is a nonprofit organization chartered in Georgia in 1974. Our club objectives is to uphold the intents and purposes as stated in the Articles of Incorporation, and to conduct sanctioned and licensed specialty shows and all AKC events for which the Club is eligible under the rules of the American Kennel Club. Further, to conduct approved GSDCA-WDA events under the authority, rules and regulations of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America Working Dog Association, Inc.

In general, Our records are vague, but it seems that The German Shepherd Club of Atlanta was founded in the 1956 when a small group of breeders and owners interested in the German Shepherd Dog met in Atlanta Georgia. The first president was Mrs. Michelle Leathers Billings. Their purpose was the improvement of the breed; through programs and activities members learn about all aspects of the German Shepherd Dog, including mental and physical development; the breed standard, working ability, breeding, care and rearing of puppies, etc. Today, the Club's goal is the same.

Our club is part of the Southeast region. In total there are <u>9 different regions</u> with about 78 registered clubs who are members of the parent club <u>German Shepherd</u> <u>Dog Club of America (GSDCA)</u>. Each club host specialty dog shows throughout the year, where fanciers/exhibitors/German Shepherd lovers a like can come together to observe and exhibit the breed.





showed up with their dogs and offered their time. Our continued involvement in these types of events truly makes us relevant and irreplaceable in our community.












To new hope, to new dreams

My two and half year adult girl is as playful and silly just as she was when she was a puppy but it is time to really hone in our training and title game.

We limited intense sports/exercises for the first two years since we were being mindful of her still growing. Now my main goal, this upcoming year, is to practice and test for both the HT and PT.

She has been in the pin several times now and she's a natural, easy

with sheep and stays engaged consistently. What we need to practice and fine tune is our recall (for the HT) and then control movement of stopping and holding (for the PT). This is my ultimate goal for her to pass each test and add those earned titles!


Now knowing these are points to work on, we'll begin practicing on focus and obedience. I have started back up again and dusted off our rally training and plan to use this as the foundation for the control and obedience I am looking for. And who knows, maybe we can improve enough where we can trial for Rally and add another title.



BREED PRACTICES

Forequarters

The shoulder blades are long and obliquely angled, laid on flat and not placed forward. The upper arm joins the shoulder blade at about a right angle. Both the upper arm and the shoulder blade are well muscled. The forelegs, viewed from all sides, are straight and the bone oval rather than round.



The pasterns are strong and springy and angulated at approximately a 25-degree angle from the vertical. Dewclaws on the forelegs may be removed, but are normally left on.

The feet are short, compact with toes well arched, pads thick and firm, nails short and dark.

A look into breed standard:

Viewed from the side, this part of the standard describes in detail what to look for and how to compare a dog to the ideal structure.

During an individual examination in conformation competition, judges initial evaluation is the visual appearance of how the front structure is put together. Then they physically examine the dog to get further insight of its built.

The owner is a registered and licensed Georgia Pet Dealer

breeding, or training for useful work (such as draft, herding, show, sporting and hunting) especially as distinguished from one suitable primarily for a pet; and is trained for and employed in meaningful work. The requirements for this definition are not met by the animal simply possessing common canine traits or characteristics."

Microchipping of sexually mature pets is required unless the owner provides documentation signed by a veterinarian that the animal is currently unable to be microchipped due to health concerns.



- 2) To define precisely and publish definition of the true type, and to urge the adoption of such types on breeders, judges, dog show committees, etc., as the only recognized and unvarying standard by which the German Shepherd Dog is to be judged, and which may in the future be uniformly accepted as the sole standard of excellence in breeding and awarding prizes of merit;
- To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of the breed by offering prizes, supporting certain shows, encouraging the development of working qualities and taking any other steps that may seem advisable;
- 4) To promote its most conspicuous characteristics as Police Dog, War Dog, Red Cross Dog, and Herding Dog, and;
- 5) To encourage therefore all trial and demonstrations in which those qualities may be shown, so as to interest the public generally, but especially the police and other municipal organizations in our ideals.

We highly recommend Membership with our Parent club.

It puts you right in the mix of what's happening in the world of GSD's.

Multiple membership options are available: Single, Family, Juniors. Dues/payments are required for Singe & Family membership but not for Juniors. 


