

# Who are We?

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta, Inc. is a nonprofit organization chartered in Georgia in 1974. Our club objectives is to uphold the intents and purposes as stated in the Articles of Incorporation, and to conduct sanctioned and licensed specialty shows and all AKC events for which the Club is eligible under the rules of the American Kennel Club. Further, to conduct approved GSDCA-WDA events under the authority, rules and regulations of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America Working Dog Association, Inc.

In general, Our records are vague, but it seems that The German Shepherd Club of Atlanta was founded in the 1956 when a small group of breeders and owners interested in the German Shepherd Dog met in Atlanta Georgia. The first president was Mrs. Michelle Leathers Billings. Their purpose was the improvement of the breed; through programs and activities members learn about all aspects of the German Shepherd Dog, including mental and physical development; the breed standard, working ability, breeding, care and rearing of puppies, etc. Today, the Club's goal is the same.

Our club is part of the Southeast region. In total there are <u>9 different regions</u> with about 78 registered clubs who are members of the parent club <u>German Shepherd</u> <u>Dog Club of America (GSDCA)</u>. Each club host specialty dog shows throughout the year, where fanciers/exhibitors/German Shepherd lovers a like can come together to observe and exhibit the breed.




Extract/Summary of Bylaws- Article II, Section 1:

(a) **ACTIVE MEMBERS** shall be individuals who subscribe to the club objectives and who have met the requirements of Bylaws. They are eligible to exercise all the privileges of membership with the exception of holding a Board of Directors position until those requirements have been meet.

Silver (FITS) - Total of 10 points

Eligibility Clubs: AKC licensed and member clubs, AKC FIT DOG Clubs, and AKC CGC Evaluators are eligible to hold AKC FIT DOG events such as runs, or group walks/hikes.

Gold (FITG) - Total of 20 points

Eligible Dogs: Dogs who are at least 6 months old and have an AKC, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners number when the Title Application is submitted are eligible to earn the Bronze AKC FIT DOG TITLE. Dogs must be registered or enrolled with AKC.

GRANDFATHERING AKC TITLES: Until further notice, titles previously earned for categories E and F can be grandfathered. This means that if your dog earned a title before the AKC FIT DOG titles began, you may count it. Each title may only be counted one time toward an AKC FIT DOG title. For example, if your dog earned the Novice Agility title before AKC FIT DOG titles began, you may count it. If it was used for the Bronze AKC FIT DOG title, the Novice Agility title may not be submitted again for Silver or Gold





# LET'S TALK SHOULDERS

Every dog regardless of breed or mixed breed has two bones in the front assembly. The two bones of the fore-

assembly are the "shoulder blade (scapula) and the upper arm (humerus). The "front assembly" is also known as "the fore assembly". The size, shape, and angle of the fore assembly will determine how the dog looks in profile as well as how the dog moves. For the most part, the angle of the shoulder of working, herding and sporting breeds call for a well laid back or "well angulated shoulder" depending on the original purpose of the breed and its function.

How do we examine the fore-assembly on our German Shepherd Dog? Place your thumb and index finger of your right hand at the point of the shoulder blades (at the top of the point of the shoulder) place the same fingers of the left hand at the end of the shoulder (where the shoulder blade joins the upper arm). Try this on different dogs to see if you can detect a difference in the length and angle of the shoulder blade. Place your index finger on the upper arm where it attaches to the shoulder blade, follow the blade to where it is attached

to the fore-leg. Can you determine the length and angle of the upper arm?

The fore-assemble affects other parts of the dog. For example; a short, upright shoulder blade makes for a shorter neck AND A LONG-ER BACK which affects the dog's balance. It is common to see a short upper arm (humerus) associated with a short upright shoulder blade. This incorrect foreassembly pushes the entire "fore-assembly" forward resulting in lack of fore-chest and now you have limited lung and heart space in the fore-chest which inhibits a working/herding breed.


In conclusion, for a dog to exhibit a fluid, ground covering gait the dog must be blessed with a foreassembly consisting of a well-laid back shoulder blade (NOT UPRIGHT) of good length, which is attached to an upper arm which is also of good length AND attached at an angle. A shoulder which is well laid back, of correct length and attached to short upper arm will result in an up and down motion of the foreleg or a very short step in front. Throughout the history of our breed, wise and successful breeders have recognized how difficult it is to recover those rare and extraordinary front assembles once they are lost. Certain pre-potent stud dogs and brood bitches have been known for producing correct front assemblies - do you know who they were/are?

# BREED STANDARD

# Hindquarters & Tail

**Hindquarters:** The whole assembly of the thigh, viewed from the side, is broad, with both upper and lower thigh well muscled, forming as nearly as possible a right angle. The upper thigh bone parallels the shoulder blade while the lower thigh bone parallels the upper arm\*. The metatarsus (the unit between the hock joint and the foot) is short, strong and tightly articulated. The dewclaws, if any, should be removed from the hind legs. Feet as in front [are short, compact with toes well arched, pads thick and firm, nails short and dark].

**Tail**: bushy, with the last vertebra extended at least to the hock joint. It is set smoothly into the croup and low rather than high. At rest, the tail hangs in a slight curve like a saber. A slight hook-sometimes carried to one side-is faulty only to the extent that it mars general appearance. When the dog is excited or in motion, the curve is accentuated and the tail raised, but it should never be curled forward beyond a vertical line. Tails too short, or with clumpy ends due to ankylosis, are serious faults. A dog with a docked tail must be disqualified.



#### A look into breed standard:

Viewed from the side, this part of the standard describes in detail what to look for and how to compare a dog to the idea structure.

During an individual examination in conformation competition, judges initial evaluation is the visual appearance of how the structure is put together. Then the physically examination of the dog is completed to get further insight of its built.

\*Alignment/parallels appear when dog is standing foursquare with foot beneath hip socket, not in show pose

#### END OF SESSION REVIEW First Term 2023-2024



GEORGIA CANINE COALITION, INC. GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY END OF SESSION REVIEW First Term 2023-2024

Below is the report of the end of the First Term of the Two-Year Session (2023-2024). If a bill did not pass this session, it can be considered in the next Session starting in January 2024.

#### HOUSE BILLS

HB 33 – To amend Chapter 50 of title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to veterinarians and veterinary technicians, so as to provide for the State Board of Veterinary Medicine to be an independent state agency attached to the Department of Agriculture for administrative purposes only, and for other purposes. Assigned to House Agriculture and Consumer Affairs Committee. Withdrawn and recommitted on 3/29/23.

HB 217- To amend Part 1 of Article 2 of Chapter 12 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to gambling, so as to revise provisions relative to dog fighting; to prohibit fighting of dogs and gamecocks; to prohibit possession or sale of fighting related objects, and for other purposes. The GCC submitted substitute language so that the use of treadmills and other common dog training, conditioning and physical therapy equipment cannot be misinterpreted as illegal activity. Assigned to House Judiciary - Non-Civil Committee. Did not move.

HB 423 – To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions relative to dangerous instrumentalities and practices, so as to revise provisions relating to harming a law enforcement animal; to provide for the offense of interfering with a public safety animal, and for other purposes. Assigned to House Judiciary – Non-Civil Committee. Did not move.

HB 573 – To amend Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to animal protection generally, so as to prohibit the marketing and transferring of certain domestic animals at certain locations, and for other purposes. This addresses sales and transfers of pets on roadsides, parking lots and certain other public areas, Assigned to House Agriculture and Consumer Affairs Committee. Did not move.









- 5) To encourage therefore all trial and demonstrations in which those qualities may be shown, so as to interest the public generally, but especially the police and other municipal organizations in our ideals.




