



Articles of Incorporation Of

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta, Inc.

- I. The name of the corporation is: "THE GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG CLUB OF ATLANTA, INC."
- II. The corporation shall have perpetual duration.
- III. The corporation is organized for the following purposes:
 - a. To encourage and promote the intelligent and selective breeding of purebred German Shepherd dogs and to do all possible to bring their qualities to perfection and encourage scientific research for the improvement of the breed.
 - b. To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of the breed by upholding the standard of the German Shepherd dog as described by the American Kennel Club and by encouraging members to support competition at conformation dog shows and obedience trials through entries, sportsmanship, and other means of suitable nature.
 - c. To educate the public generally as to the uses, habits, characteristics, advantages, training, care, companionship and treatment of German Shepherd dogs.
 - d. The corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property of the corporation and no profit if its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of the director or any other private individual. The corporation shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit or in any other activity except in furtherance of the purposes stated above, for which the corporation is organized. The corporation shall never be authorized to engage in any business which may preclude its exemption under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, Section 501 (c), as amended.
- IV. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of election of directors shall be as determined by the by-laws of the corporation.
- V. The initial registered office of the corporation created.
- VI. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of nine (9) members.
- VII. Membership in the corporation shall be determined as follows:
 - a. A prerequisite for membership is an interest in the German Shepherd dog with expressed intention to uphold the intents, purposes, and objects of the corporation as set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. Any worthy person, sixteen (16) years of age or older, may apply for membership as provided in the by-laws.
 - b. There shall be four classes of membership in The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta, Inc.: (1) active; (2) associate; (3) life; (4) honorary. Qualifications for the various classes of membership are provided in the by-laws.

Our purpose is to advocate for the breed; through programs and activities members learn about all aspects of the German Shepherd Dog, including mental and physical development; the breed standard, working ability, breeding, care and rearing of puppies.





The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta, Inc. is a nonprofit organization chartered in Georgia in 1974. Our club objectives are to uphold the intents and purposes as stated in the Articles of Incorporation, and to conduct sanctioned and licensed specialty shows and all AKC events for which the Club is eligible under the rules of the American Kennel Club. Further, to conduct approved GSDCA -WDA events under the authority, rules and regulations of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America Working Dog Association, Inc.



The GSDC of Atlanta is one of the many registered clubs in America who are part of the breed parent club, the German Shepherd Dog Club of America (GSDCA). These clubs are split into 7 different regions, where we reside in the Southeast Region.



I joined the GSDC of Atlanta in 1972, moved out of the area and continued in obedience with my dogs until we moved back to Atlanta in 1984. I rejoined the club in 1988 after my old dogs had died and I purchased a puppy from Caralon Kennels.

I've had dogs that were shown in conformation, obedience, rally, herding, FastCat, and dabbled in tracking and nose work.

Club's Breeder Referral

I offer referrals towards our club members first. If I don't know of any club puppies, I offer names of others local to our area that I know offer a good dog and will stand behind their puppies. And I give no preferences to anyone – I try to be as unbiased as possible.

The below questions are based on my experience as a breeder and owner. My first dog purchase in 1968 was an inbred father/daughter litter, and he had the most titles of any dog in his 5-generation pedigree – a CDX. I will credit him with establishing my love of the breed and we had a lot of fun.

Members, keep me in the loop! Let me know if you're having puppies, planning a litter, or have a dog you want to place.

Questions that I ask callers

Have you ever owned a GSD before

What area of town do you live in or does it matter how far away the puppy is located

Do you have a fenced yard or what is your exercise plan

Do you want a puppy or an older dog

What do you want to do with your dog - pet, show, performance, etc.

How did you find out about the club

Questions I advise callers to ask the person with puppies. Callers frequently know of "puppies" from a friend knows someone who has a litter.

What health screenings do the parents have, i.e. OFA, DM, etc.

Make sure you meet the dam of the puppies, if you don't like her leave

How old is the dam

Do they have both parents on site

I tell everyone that calls – your dog needs a job – if you don't give him one, they will make their own job.

Everyone has their own hot buttons and these are mine. I've been fortunate to have great mentors over the years. Scootie Sherlock of Caralon Kennels, was my first mentor and was always there for me even after I no longer had a dog from her bloodlines. Find yourself a mentor and then listen.

BREED STANDARD - TEMPERAMENT

Under GSDC of America—German Shepherd Standard—Temperament

The breed has a distinct personality marked by direct and fearless, but not hostile, expression, self-confidence and a certain aloofness that does not lend itself to immediate and indiscriminate friendships. The dog must be approachable, quietly standing its ground and showing confidence and willingness to meet overtures without itself making them. It is poised, but when the occasion demands, eager and alert; both fit and willing to serve in its capacity as companion, watchdog, blind leader, herding dog, or guardian, whichever the circumstances may demand. The dog must not be timid, shrinking behind its master or handler; it should not be nervous, looking about or upward with anxious expression or showing nervous reactions, such as tucking of tail, to strange sounds or sights.

Lack of confidence under any surroundings is not typical of good character. Any of the above deficiencies in character which indicate shyness must be penalized as very serious faults and any dog exhibiting pronounced indications of these must be excused from the ring. It must be possible for the judge to observe the teeth and to determine that both testicles are descended.

Any dog that attempts to bite the judge must be disqualified. The ideal dog is a working animal with an incorruptible character combined with body and gait suitable for the arduous work that constitutes its primary purpose.

For Comparison...

Under 23.12.2010/EN FCI-Standard N°166 -German Shepherd Dog Standard - Character

The German Shepherd Dog must be well-balanced (with strong nerves) in terms of character, self-assured, absolutely natural and (except for a stimulated situation) good-natured as well as attentive and willing to please. He must possess instinctive behaviour, resilience and self-assurance in order to be suitable as a companion, guard, protection, service and herding dog.

Under UKC- German Shepherd Dog Standard- CHARACTERISTICS

The German Shepherd Dog is confident and fearless, willing to be approached, yet a certain level of aloofness towards strangers is acceptable. When working, the German Shepherd is alert and eager, adapting well to new tasks. Lack of confidence is a serious defect in the character of a German Shepherd. Lack of confidence, timid or shrinking behavior must be excused from the ring. The structure of this breed was designed for efficient locomotion, particularly at the trot.

Under GSDC of Canada—German Shepherd Standard—Temperament

The breed has a distinct personality marked by a direct and fearless, but not hostile, expression, and self-confidence and a certain aloofness, which does not lend itself to immediate and indiscriminate friendships. The Shepherd Dog is not one that fawns upon every new acquaintance. At the same time, it should be approachable, quietly standing its ground and showing confidence and a willingness to meet overtures without itself making them. It should be poised, but when the occasion demands, eager and alert, both fit and willing to serve in any capacity as companion, watch dog, blind leader, herding dog or guardian; whichever the circumstances may demand. The Shepherd Dog must not be timid, shrinking behind its master or handler, nervous, looking about or upward with anxious expression or showing nervous reactions to strange sounds or sights, or lackadaisical, sluggish, or manifestly disinterested in what goes on about him. Lack of confidence under any surroundings is not typical of good character. Cases of extreme timidity and nervous unbalance sometimes give the dog an apparent, but totally unreal, courage and it becomes a "fear biter," snapping not for any justifiable reason but because it is apprehensive of the approach of a stranger. This is a serious fault subject to heavy penalty.



German Shepherd Dog Club of America

The German Shepherd Dog Club of America, Inc., also known as the Parent Club for the GSD, was formed in 1913 & incorporated February 7, 1916.

The purposes for which the Corporation was formed are listed below:

- 1) To promote the breeding of the German Shepherd Dog;
- 2) To define precisely and publish definition of the true type, and to urge the adoption of such types on breeders, judges, dog show committees, etc., as the only recognized and unvarying standard by which the German Shepherd Dog is to be judged, and which may in the future be uniformly accepted as the sole standard of excellence in breeding and awarding prizes of merit;
- 3) To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of the breed by offering prizes, supporting certain shows, encouraging the development of working qualities and taking any other steps that may seem advisable;
- 4) To promote its most conspicuous characteristics as Police Dog, War Dog, Red Cross Dog, and Herding Dog, and;
- 5) To encourage therefore all trial and demonstrations in which those qualities may be shown, so as to interest the public generally, but especially the police and other municipal organizations in our ideals.

We highly recommend Membership with our Parent club.

A Message from the Review Management Committee.....

The Review Management Committee has carefully studied other parent club breed magazines, and our findings indicate that the Top 10 breed-specific parent club publications are online only, quarterly, or bi-monthly. Currently, the GSD Review relies on up to 62% of yearly membership dues to maintain its eleven issues per year. After extensive deliberation, the GSDCA Board has decided to publish the Review bi-monthly, starting with the July/August 2024 edition. This shift will reduce the percentage of dues required to support the Review and provide a manageable workload for our dedicated volunteers. The GSDCA Board and the Review Committee are confident that this bi-monthly publishing model will ensure long-term stability and free up substantial funds for other club member benefits.

The Review has had many management iterations, from using a paid editor to an all-volunteer committee. We found that the salaried editor model was successful but also could have been more cost-effective. Another successful model was a volunteer committee of members who combined their talent and efforts to produce a high-quality magazine. However, having only volunteers as a workforce created other challenges, which is where we are now.

The Board considered and approved a new hybrid version of the volunteer Review Committee that consists of a volunteer committee and Chair supported by a professional production coordinator. The goal is to provide quality publications more efficiently and continue supporting all aspects of the German Shepherd Dog.











